

**REPORTING STUDENTS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF OR
POSSESSING NON-INTOXICATING BEVERAGES, ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES OR CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES**

POLICY

It is the policy of the Board of Education of Tulsa Technology Center that the use, possession or distribution of any non-intoxicating beverage (as defined by Oklahoma law, i.e., 3.2 beer), alcoholic beverage or controlled dangerous substance is prohibited during school hours, on school property, on school buses or at any event sponsored by the District.

This policy applies to any student attending any program, class or activity under the supervision of the District.

Whenever it appears to any instructor or other school employee that a student may be under the influence of a non-intoxicating beverage, an alcoholic beverage or controlled dangerous substance, that instructor or employee shall report the matter, upon recognition, to the campus director. The campus director shall immediately notify the superintendent or his/her designee. If the student involved is a high school student, the campus director shall also notify the superintendent of the student's district of residence or his/her designee and the student's parent(s) or legal guardian.

No employee of the district or member of the school board shall be subject to any civil liability for any statement, report, or action taken in assisting or referring for assistance to any medical treatment or social service agency or facility any student reasonably believed to be abusing or incapacitated by the use of a controlled dangerous substance unless such assistance or referral was made in bad faith or with malicious purpose.
