Purpose: The purpose of the Tulsa Technology Education Foundation (TTCEF) is to provide funds needed by students to pursue specific career and technical training programs at TTC.

TTCEF has a limited number of financial aid scholarships which are awarded based on merit, need and availability of scholarship funds. Awards are made at the discretion of the scholarship selection committee (TTCEF board members). The TTCEF does not make loans to students. The TTCEF does not guarantee any candidate receipt of any form of scholarship attendance. The TTCEF does not discriminate because of race, color, national origin, age, sex or handicap. Scholarships awarded to current TTC students only.

Categories for Financial Aid: Awards are for an unmet need for necessary school expenses and should not exceed \$300 per student per year and include the following:

Payment Disbursement: Award checks will be sent to the school or vendor directly. No payments will be made directly to the student.

Deadline: There is no deadline for applications, however, the TTCEF board meets only once a month to review applications and interview candidates. Those applicants with completed applications will be called to schedule an interview. **PLEASE ALLOW 2-4 WEEKS FOR PROCESSING AND REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS.**

To be considered for a TTCEF scholarship you must:

1. Be a fully admitted student at TTC with at least 30 days of class attendance (provide attendance records).
2. Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
3. **Complete the scholarship application in full.** (Faxed applications will not be accepted)
4. Include a letter of recommendation from a Counselor or Instructor.
5. Include a one page essay describing your career goals and why this scholarship is important to you.
6. Include grades and attendance report from the Registrar.
7. Explain your need clearly and submit documentation of costs.
8. Include an itemized invoice of the equipment, tools or supplies requested.
9. Indicate annual household income and specify number in household.
10. Indicate if you are receiving or will receive financial aid on the application
