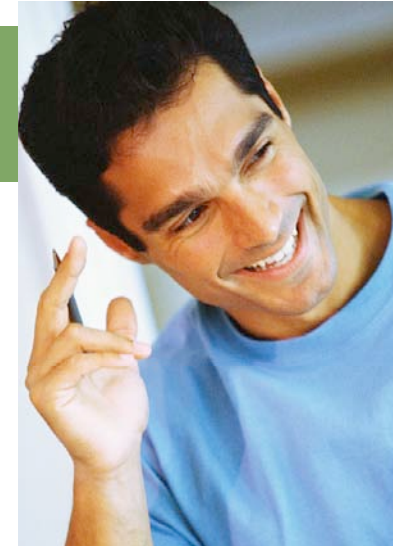

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE



Grants ■ Scholarships

There is no greater return on investment than that of a quality education. Adults who plan to attend Tulsa Technology Center have several financial aids, grants and scholarship opportunities from which to select for application so they can start realizing their goals and dreams.

It is the policy of the Board of Education of Tulsa Technology Center that tuition scholarships may be established and awarded to deserving students in the following categories:

### **C**areer and Technology Student Organizations Scholarships

Tuition scholarship may be established and awarded to current student members of a Career and Technology Student Organization (CTSO) who place first, second, or third in state CTSO competitive activities or who are elected as CTSO officers at the district, state, or national levels.

### **C**areers Unlimited Training Program

Waivers provide financial assistance for technical training to individuals meeting income criteria who are entering into non-traditional training. All training is provided at Tulsa Technology Center.

### **D**isplaced Homemaker/Single Parent Program

Waivers provide financial assistance for technical training to individuals meeting income criteria who are entering into our training. All training is provided at Tulsa Technology Center.

### **F**ederal and State Financial Assistance Program

Tulsa Technology Center participates in the Federal Pell Grant Program and the Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grants Program. Tulsa Tech does not participate in the Stafford Loan, Plus or SLS Program.





### High School Career Path Scholarship

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide a high school student the opportunity to complete his/her technical training program as a postsecondary student tuition free if he/she was not able to finish it prior to graduation. Many Tulsa Tech technical programs have an identified career path that describes the recommended sequence of programs, with several options within the pathway in some instances. 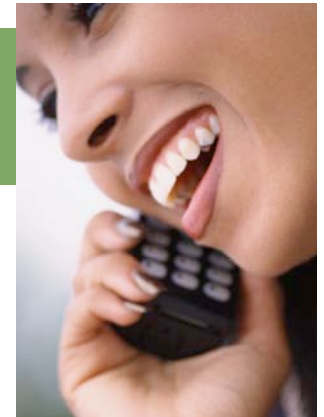
### Junior Achievement of Greater Tulsa Scholarship

### Tulsa Technology Center Education Foundation Financial Awards

The Tulsa Technology Center Education Foundation was founded in 1983 to provide for student needs that could not be funded with public tax dollars. **Note:** The payment of tuition and fees must be made two weeks (ten working days) prior to the start of classes or admission will be denied. Students applying for financial assistance through grants, waivers or scholarships should begin the enrollment process well in advance of the start of class. Grants, waivers, or scholarships can take as long as 6 weeks to process.
