PATHWAYS SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION PROCESS

General Guidelines

The Tulsa Tech **Pathways Scholarship** provides free tuition to an eligible recipient in any Tulsa Technology Center full-time program. Recipients will be awarded the scholarship for only one complete full-time program.

The **Pathways Scholarship** covers only tuition and will in no case result in direct payments to recipients. Students who fail to complete the program are not eligible for payment of a refund for any unused part of the scholarship. Currently enrolled students who have paid a fee to hold their enrollment in a program who become qualified recipients of the **Pathways Scholarship** will be given a refund for any fee or tuition that has been pre-paid.

The **Pathways Scholarship** does not apply to the cost of tools, books, uniforms, insurance, instructional materials, certification/licensure exams, or other associated costs.

Recipient Eligibility Guidelines

Eligible recipients include students in one of the following two categories:

1. Students who are currently enrolled as a junior or senior in a multi-year full-time program and need more time to complete the program after graduation from high school are eligible recipients. In order to receive the **Pathways Scholarship**, applicants who are currently enrolled must have met all requirements for enrollment in the adult program and must have made satisfactory progress throughout his/her enrollment while still in high school.
2. Students who have graduated from high school during the current school year and did not attend Tulsa Technology Center during their high school years, but desire to enroll in a full-time Tulsa Technology Center program during the year immediately following graduation from a public, private, parochial, charter or home school located within the boundaries of the Tulsa Technology Center School District, are eligible recipients. **Enrollment for this category is on a space-available basis.**

Pathways Scholarship Application Process

1. Complete Tulsa Technology Center's adult admission process.
2. Meet program admission criteria.
3. Submit application for the **Pathways Scholarship to Financial Assistance Office** located at the Career Services Center, 3420 South Memorial Drive, Tulsa, OK 74145-1390. Office hours are Monday-Friday, 7:30am - 4:30pm. The telephone number for Financial Services is 918-828-5156 or 918-828-5215.
4. Provide copy of diploma or transcript showing graduation from a public, private, parochial, charter or home school located within the boundaries of the Tulsa Technology Center District.
5. If currently enrolled in Tulsa Technology Center as a high school student, provide proof of satisfactory progress while enrolled.

Retention of the Pathways Scholarship

All recipients of the **Pathways Scholarship** must meet the following requirements to retain the scholarship:

1. Meet all requirements included in Board of Education policies and procedures and student handbooks.
2. Maintain satisfactory progress throughout enrollment in the program.
3. Maintain continuous enrollment until completion of the program.
4. Exceptions may be approved by the Superintendent or Associate Superintendent.
